Thanks for your email and apologies for the confusion. To clarify, three updates are required to the CEMD:

1. Additional of the Ground Gas and Groundwater Report.
2. Amendment to the Construction Method Statement (Chapter 2), as the appendices were missing from the version that was sent on Friday.
3. Minor update to Chapter 1 to include a reference to the Ground Gas and Groundwater Report.

To address these changes we'll take the following action today:

- Consultees who requested CD/USB copies of the CEMD: these were posted on Saturday for guaranteed delivery by 13.00 today. Nichelle Murray at Arup (cc'ed) will email these consultees to explain the changes listed above, attach copies of the three revised chapters, and confirm that all other chapters are unchanged. Please let me have any comments on the draft plan documents by Friday 24 March.

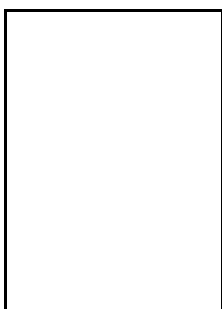
