Currently the position is RAPID-C19 has not considered the evidence is there to recommend deployment. The route for advice in the face of any changing information to go back to RAPID-C19 via the team at NICE

Obviously if ministers are considering deployment when the clinical advice structures have not considered that appropriate then we need to discuss at the earliest stage.
