Design

- Another programme for Room Reviews has been issued, with reviews now programmed until the 15th December. To date we have reviewed 35th of the 2071 rooms in the building. Against the revised programme we have completed 64% of the rooms that were programmed to be reviewed by the 3th November, the remaining 36th were not in a fit state to be reviewed as works were not finished or there was no power. The revised programme does not take account of the fact that we will need to re-review every room again due to the number of becamions made by the Project Team in relation to the quality of workmanship and missing items. We are awaiting a programme from Multiplex for the reviews and also for the Red Rooms' (those that were not able to be reviewed at the scheduled time). A significant number of scheduled room reviews are being cancelled at the last minute and are requiring to be rescheduled help and the specific carried out by CAAI on the 27th Clober. A 2th inspection will occur in 3.4 months time once snagging issues have been addressed, the support accommodation is complete and a test flight carried out. BABCOCKS one of the main helicopter operators were in attendance and carried out their survey which is needed prior to helicopters landing. The relation stream of RFIs in relation to design and future 8 fittings queries that we are responding to.

 The Internal Wayfinding & Signage RDD pack has now been signed off. We are continuing to reviewing Room Data Sheets as they are submitted Design meetings are continuing in relation to a number of radiology rooms including the intra-operative MRI.

 The design for the ECHC shop has now concluded and a responsibility matrix agreed for the works to be carried out.
