QUESTION	RESPONSE
1. Does your CCG commission a Community VTE Clinic?	The VTE clinic is managed by the Oxford University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust (OUH) and, as such, Oxfordshire CCG does not hold the information being requested.
2. In the last 12 months how many patients have been treated at the clinic?	May we suggest you contact Oxford University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust as they may be able to provide the data required.
3. How many patients have been treated with a Direct Oral Anticoagulants (DOAC) within the clinic?	Please note: FOI responses may take longer to complete at the moment as the Trust may need to prioritise essential services to ensure the wellbeing of our residents. The Information Commissioners Office (ICO) has advised that although they are unable to extend statutory timescales, they will advise people that they may experience understandable delays when making FOIs during the COVID-19 pandemic.
4. Of these patients how many were treated with: a) Xarelto b) Lixiana c) Pradaxa d) Eliquis	Oxfordshire CCG does not know the number of patients treated with a DOAC so we are not able to specify which DOACs patients are using
