What were the start and end times of the monitoring activity on 21 April 2021 by Community Speed Watch for eastbound traffic and westbound traffic in Fleggburgh.

Norfolk Constabulary has considered your request and our response is below.

Our records do not tell us what time the volunteers began and finished monitoring.

We can confirm what time the first and last offences were. The first offence was detected at 14:21 hours and the final offence was at 14:30 hours
