Thank you for your Fol request of 27 July. You asked:

"Please provide the number of complaints received regarding the removal of SMI benefit.

Also specify how many legal notices where claimants have threatened or intend to take legal action due to the removal of SMI benefit.

How many Court cases are due because of the removal of SMI benefit?"

There have been 9 complaints received from Pension Age claimants regarding the removal of SMI benefit. The Department does not hold information that would enable us to determine how many complaints have been received from working age claimants regarding the removal of SMI benefit.

There have been 2 occasions where claimants have indicated their intention to take legal action specifically due to the removal of SMI as a benefit. Further to this 3 claimants have indicated their intention to take legal action about other issues relating to SMI loans.

There are currently no Court cases due specifically as a result of the removal of SMI benefit.
