Dear Mr James

Thank you for your email of 26 February 2019 where you requested information about compliancy checks on vessels visiting the Humber estuary and the port of Humber in 2018.

The MCA has carried out 218 inspections, and of those inspections 105 have had a sample of fuel oil taken and analysed to establish the sulphur content of that fuel. The ports where these inspections have taken place are: Grimsby, Hull, Immingham and Killingholme. I am unaware of any port called Humber in UK. The inspections and sample testing have been carried out in accordance with the requirements set out in EU directive and UK law.
