Dear Ms Shah,

Your request was received on 26 January 2017 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').

You asked:

I request the number of applicants and offers between 2013-2016 inclusive arranged by college for Computer Science via Natural Sciences.

Students may plan to switch courses from Natural Sciences to Computer Science but there is no such 'route' recorded at the point of application and accordingly this information is not held.

Generally, the Information Commissioner cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by the University.
