
BEIS Energy and Climate Change Public Attitudes Tracker (PAT) Steering Group Meeting Minutes



<u>Item</u>	Key points from discussion					
1.	This meeting was centred around providing the steering group members with an					
	update on the new PAT contract.					
	Question areas					
	Following on from the consultation (both internal and external), it was agreed that					
	we would expand the content of the survey to cover other key policy areas for the					
	department (aside from energy).					
	Survey modules					
	The addition of a number of new questions has meant that it would be more fitting					
	to rearrange the structure of the current survey. This means rather than having one					
	annual survey with all the questions, and then three subsequent surveys where					
	questions are repeated throughout the year, it has been agreed (with the					
	contractors and BEIS) to adopt modular approach. This means that each wave will					
	have a module of questions. So far we have agreed a module on consumer					
	rights/experience, employment rights, climate change/science and all energy					
	related questions that are currently on the survey to continue on the April wave.					
	However, it is likely that a few energy related questions will feature throughout the					
	year (as the previous survey had a large proportion of energy related questions). It

has been agreed with policy and that the consumer rights/experience module will feature in wave 26, kicking off the new survey.

Survey outputs
