NATIONAL CONCESSIONARY FUEL AGREEMENT FOR CLERICAL STAFF

This Agreement is made this Fifteenth day of August 1989, between the BRITISH COAL CORPORATION (hereinafter referred to as the Corporation) of the one part and the National Union of Mineworkers (NUM) and the Association of Professional, Executive and Computer Staffs, (APEX) (hereinafter referred to as the Unions) of the other part.

It is hereby agreed between the Corporation and the Unions as follows:-

1. CLERICAL STAFF COVERED

(i) Serving Staff

Full Time Clerical and sub clerical staff who satisfy the conditions of eligibility.

(ii) Beneficiaries

A retired clerical officer/clerk, a redundant clerical officer/clerk, or a widow/widower of a serving member of full time clerical staff, or the widow/widower of a clerical beneficiary, who satisfy the conditions of eligibility.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

For the purposes of this Agreement:

THE CORPORATION means the British Coal Corporation and wholly owned subsidiaries where clerical staff are employed, and for whom the Unions are recognised to negotiate.

THE UNIONS mean NUM (COSA) and APEX

CLERICAL OFFICER/CLERK means:-

- (i) Clerical and Junior Administrative staff covered by the 1968 Clerical Agreement; and
- (ii) Messengers/Commissionaires Chauffeurs Area Security Officers (not on BACM grades) Assistant Area Security Officers X-Ray Technicians

who are employed full time and who are employed in a coalfield.

NORMAL RETIREMENT AGE means either the Corporation's normal retirement age as defined from time to time or the normal retirement age under the Staff Superannuation Scheme as defined from time to time, whichever is applicable.

RETIRED CLERICAL OFFICER/CLERK means a clerical officer/clerk who leaves the Corporation's service and qualifies as a compensation case, ill health case, and a clerical officer/clerk who leaves at normal retirement age, or under the terms of the Corporation's schemes for Voluntary Early Retirement.

REDUNDANT CLERICAL OFFICER/ CLERK means a person whose contract of employment has been terminated by the Corporation and who is thereby entitled to a redundancy payment under the Employment Protection (Consolidation) Act as re-enacted from time to time.

SUPPORTING SON/DAUGHTER means a clerical officer/clerk who resides in the parental home, but who provides the main or sole financial support for the household.

WIDOW/WIDOWER means the widow/widower of a clerical officer/clerk who dies in service or in retirement after the effective date of this Agreement, and who immediately prior to death was in receipt of benefit. For retired staff the marriage must take place prior to retirement

BENEFICIARY means a widow/widower, a retired clerical officer/clerk or a redundant clerical officer/clerk in receipt of benefit under this Agreement. CONCESSIONAIRE means a person in receipt of benefit under this Agreement.

BENEFIT means fuel or cash in lieu of fuel.

HOUSEHOLDER means a person:-

- (i) residing in a house or self-contained flat comprising three or more habitable rooms in addition to kitchen and bathroom, and of which he/she and his/her household, if any, have the exclusive use; and in which the domestic space and water heating arrangements are entirely separate; and
- (ii) being either:-
 - (a) the occupier of the accommodation; or
 - (b) a married person who with his/her spouse, is the joint occupier of the accommodation; or
 - (c) a supporting son/daughter where his/her parents are joint occupiers, or one of his/her parents is the occupier, of the accommodation.

QUASI-HOUSEHOLDER means a person

- (iii) residing in accommodation which comprises two or more habitable rooms in addition to kitchen and bathroom, and of which he/she and his/her household have the exclusive use; and in which the domestic space and water heating arrangements are entirely separate; and who satisfies (a) or (b) or (c) above, or a person satisfying (i) above and being:-
 - (d) the joint householder of the property;

SUB-HOUSEHOLDER means a person

(iv) residing in accommodation of which he/she, and his/her household if any, have the exclusive use, and in which the domestic space heating arrangements are entirely separate; and who satisfies (a) or (b) or (c) or (d) above; but excluding any situation where the accommodation is provided by members of the applicant's immediate family living under the same roof;

or

(v) A concessionaire who has been forced to move in with relatives or into a nursing home due to health reasons.

FULL TIME EMPLOYMENT means

- (i) for Serving Staff: those conditioned to the hours provided by the Clerical Agreement 1968, as amended from time to time and currently 37.5 hours per week;
- (ii) for Beneficiaries: those employed to work for any employer, including the Corporation, for more than 25 hours per week

FUEL YEAR means the Corporation's financial year.

MATERIAL CHANGE IN CIRCUMSTANCES means any change in the circumstances of a concessionaire relevant to his/her qualification or level or conditions of entitlement to benefit under this Agreement.

3. CATEGORIES OF BENEFICIARIES AND QUALIFICATIONS FOR BENEFIT

The categories set out below are subject in all cases to satisfying the conditions of eligibility.

Prior use: Beneficiaries

No staff will satisfy the conditions of eligibility for benefit in retirement under this Agreement unless they were in receipt of benefit immediately prior to retirement. In the case of other beneficiaries the person from whom entitlement derives must be in receipt of benefit immediately prior to death. Exceptionally an entitlement will be granted where it can be shown that the applicant or person from whom entitlement derives was in receipt of benefit for a substantial part of his/her period of eligibility for benefit.

Retired Clerical Officer/Clerk

- (i) A person who retires from the Corporation's service at normal retirement age; or
- (ii) a person who retires from the Corporation's service under the Corporation's schemes for Voluntary Early Retirement

provided in both cases that:

- (a) the individual was in receipt of benefit immediately prior to retirement; and
- (b) the individual has 10 years' service with the Corporation, including 5 years' continuous service prior to retirement.

Redundant Clerical Officer/Clerk

Where staff are age 50 or over upon redundancy they will be considered under the qualifications which apply to retired clerks/clerical officers, save for age. Where staff are aged below 50 they will continue to receive benefit for 26 weeks following termination. Thereafter benefit will cease.

Compensation Case

A person:

- (i) who by reason of injury by accident sustained or of disease contracted by him/her during the course of his/her employment by the Corporation is in receipt of compensation from the Corporation for such injury/disease; and
- (ii) whose last employment prior to such injury or disease was with the Corporation; and
- (iii) who as a result of such injury or disease is so incapacitated that he/she is unable to undertake any form of employment that the Corporation are likely to offer him/her.

Suspension of Entitlement

Entitlement will be suspended for retired and redundant staff and compensation cases during any period of full time employment, including self employment.

Sickness/Ill Health Case

A person who has retired from the Corporation's service because of ill health, provided that such ill health has been certified by the Corporation's Medical Officer as grounds for the award of an ill health retirement pension under the Staff Superannuation Scheme.

The entitlement to benefit will be for 12 months with further entitlement determined by length of service as follows:-

Length of Service	Length of Entitlement	
5 years or more	12 months	
10 years or more	24 months	
15 years or more	Life entitlement	

Cessation of Entitlement

Short term entitlements will cease permanently on full time employment including self employment and these beneficiaries will not be eligible to reapply for benefit on relinquishing employment. Life entitlements will be suspended during any period of full time employment, including self employment.

Entitlement of Widow/Widower

Subject always to satisfying the conditions of eligibility, the widow/widower of an employee/former employee who was in receipt of concessionary fuel/benefit upon death, will be eligible to apply for benefit. The conditions of eligibility for widows/widowers take into account the spouse's status upon death, the widow's/widower's age and full time employment:-

(i) Industrial Accident

Where death occurs as a result of industrial accident during service the widow/widower will receive a life entitlement.

(ii) Death in Service

The widow/widower will receive a life entitlement if aged 60 (female) or 65 (male) or over on the death of the spouse. Where aged under 60 (female) or under 65 (male) the widow/widower will receive an entitlement for 12 months with further periods according to the spouse's length of service with the Corporation as follows:-

Length of Service	Length of Entitlement
5 years or more 10 years or more	12 months 24 months
15 years or more	Life entitlement

(iii) Death in Retirement

Widows/widowers will be considered against the age and length of service criteria which apply to death in service. Entitlement for widows/widowers following death in retirement is subject to the marriage taking place prior to retirement and the widow/widower not being in full time employment on application for benefit.

Cessation of Entitlement

Short term entitlements will cease permanently on full time employment including self employment and these beneficiaries will not be eligible to re-apply for benefit on relinquishing employment. Life entitlements will be suspended during a period of full time employment, including self employment. In all cases entitlement will cease permanently should the widow/widower remarry.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Agreement will supersede the National Concessionary Fuel Agreement for Clerical Staff dated 16th April, 1985, with effect from the start of the 1989/90 Fuel Year.

5. ENTITLEMENTS

The Agreement will provide the following entitlements:-

COAL

(i) Serving Staff

Clerical staff employed in posts at collieries, coke ovens and carbonisation plants except those staff who receive anthracite as concessionary coal:-

Householder	7.5t.
Quasi-householder	5.2t.
Sub-Householder	2.6t.

Clerical staff employed in a coalfield but elsewhere than at collieries, coke ovens and carbonisation plants except those staff who receive anthracite as concessionary coal:-

Householder	5.75t.
Quasi-Householder	3.85t
Sub-Householder	1.9t.

(ii) Beneficiaries

Householder	5.0t.
Quasi-Householder	3.35t.
Sub-Householder	1.65t.

Type of Coal

Subject to availability, the type of coal to be supplied under this Agreement will normally be of the grade and quality supplied to other similar concessionaires supplied from the same depot, normally washed bituminous doubles.

SMOKELESS FUEL

Solid smokeless fuel will be supplied under this Agreement. The type of solid smokeless fuel will be at the choice of the Concessionaire from the list of concessionary fuel available at his supply depot. The quantity of solid smokeless fuel to be supplied will depend upon the fuel type, the householder status of the Concessionaire, the region in which he/she resides and his/her age. The quantity of solid smokeless fuel to which the Concessionaire is entitled in any fuel year is set out in Appendix 1 to this schedule. With effect from 1 April 1993 any concessionaire who has reached the age of 80 years in the fuel year will receive from the following fuel year one additional 50kg bag of the chosen fuel. Solid smokeless fuel will be delivered by the Corporation in bags.

In exceptional circumstances, where the price of a smokeless fuel increases substantially out of line with the general trend of fuel prices, it may be appropriate to refuse to supply that particular fuel, nationally or locally. Any such action to withdraw a fuel will only be taken after the Corporation has consulted the appropriate trade union representatives and only when a suitable alternative fuel is available to concessionaires. Any fuel which has been withdrawn will only be re-introduced at the same tonnage entitlement as was available at the time of its withdrawal.

The quantity of any new solid smokeless fuel to be supplied will be determined by dividing the new weighted average cash value of the existing available fuel entitlements by the retail price of the new fuel. The weighted average cash value of the existing available fuels will be determined according to the class of concessionaire and household status in each price region.

Living Remote to a Coalfield Area

If a beneficiary entitled to concessionary fuel resides outside the area within which the Corporation normally deliver Concessionary fuel, the corporation will arrange through either BFL or a local merchant to supply him with concessionary fuel to the value of his entitlement. The value of an entitlement will be calculated in the case of coal at the average pithead prices in the district which includes his parent unit until 30 September 1989, thereafter the calculation of the value will be increased to include district average delivery costs as determined from time to time by the Corpration; or, in the case of solid smokeless fuel, the average price of Sunbrite at depots within the district from which concessionaires from his parent unit are normally supplied until 1st April 1993. Thereafter, each concessionaire living remote of a coalfield Area, whether receiving coal or solid smokeless fuel will have an annual entitlement derived on an individual basis, using a national weighted average cash value of the existing available fuels according to the class of concessionaire and household status divided by the local merchant's current price of that fuel.

6. CHARGES FOR COAL AND DELIVERY

(i) Serving Staff

The charge for coal and delivery will be the full economic delivery charge for coal based upon the overall average actual delivery cost per tonne of coal delivered to clerical concessionaires in the previous year. Staff will pay a uniform charge for coal, phased to reach the full economic cost of delivery with effect from the Fuel Year commencing April 1991, as follows:

(ii) Beneficiaries

For the 6 month period 1st April, 1989 - 30th September, 1989 beneficiaries will pay for coal and delivery at the same rate applicable to serving staff as in (i) above. Thereafter, bagging and delivery of coal to beneficiaries will be free of charge. These arrangements do not affect payments made by those in receipt of a customary practice entitlement.

Pre-packed coal

The Corporation reserve the right to pass on any additional pre-packing charge for specially prepared coals, such as Coalflow Pearls, taken by serving staff. Such additional charges are payable by beneficiaries until 30th September 1989 only.

7. CASH IN LIEU

Any person who is entitled to concessionary fuel under the terms of the Agreement will be entitled to take cash in lieu of such fuel provided he/she satisfies the conditions of eligibility and subject to any other relevant provisions of the Agreement.

Cash in lieu will be payable if the Corporation are satisfied that any of the following conditions is met:

- (i) the heating of the house is by a coal-fired district heating scheme; or
- (ii) the concessionaire suffers from a chronic medical condition such that the use of any type of solid fuel is injurious to his/her health; or
- (iii) the concessionaire suffers from a chronic disability such that he/she is physically unable to handle solid fuel and there is no member of his/her household who can do this instead; or
- (iv) where a concessionaire or a member of his/her household is disabled and the household is moved to special accommodation for the disabled which is heated by other than solid fuel, the concessionaire will be eligible for cash in lieu, provided that:
 - (a) it is not reasonably practicable to adapt the previous accommodation;
 - (b) there is no suitable accommodation heated by solid fuel available in the district;
 - (c) the new accommodation is held on a tenure which requires the household to vacate the property once the disabled member ceases to require it;

provided that in the case of (ii) or (iii) the relevant condition is the immediate cause of the concessionaire ceasing to use solid fuel.

Material Change in Circumstances affecting Cash in Lieu Allowance

The Corporation will not pay cash in lieu to a concessionaire who moves house or whose domestic heating arrangements are altered, for any reason, on or after 1st August 1984, so as to preclude the use of solid fuel, unless the granting of cash in lieu has been authorised in writing by the Corporation before such move or alteration takes place.

Amount

The annual rates of cash in lieu payments for cases arising on or after 1st April, 1989, whether by virtue of being a new applicant or an existing cash in lieu recipient re-applying due to a material change in circumstances, are £240 for a householder, £160 for a quasi-householder and £80 for a sub-householder. The £240 rate (and others pro-rata) remains frozen until overtaken by £200 as at October 1988 indexed each subsequent October by the July to July percentage increase of the fuel and light component of the Retail Price Index, after which the £200 indexed figure will apply.

Amount from 1st October 1994:-

Full householder	£264.48
Quasi householder	£176.32
Sub householder	£ 88.16

For existing cases as at 31st March, 1989 the annual rates until 30th June, 1989 are those established in October 1987, i.e. £375 for a householder, £250 for a quasi-householder and £125 for a sub-householder, unlessat a higher protected rate resulting from a previous Agreement. From 1st July, 1989 all such rates will be revised to £360 for a householder, £240 for a quasi-householder and £120 for a sub-householder. These latter rates continue to apply whilst ever the concessionaire or his widow remains in receipt of cash in lieu.

When a concessionaire in receipt of either fuel or cash in lieu, is forced due to health reasons, to give up his/her own independent property to live with relatives or into a nursing home, he/she is entitled to a cash allowance equivalent to that of teh sub householder rate, currently £88.16 per year.

8. CASH BALANCES

No cash payments will be made for the balance of any fuel untaken at the end of the fuel year for serving staff or beneficiaries.

9. GENERAL CONDITIONS

Concessionary fuel supplied under this Agreement shall be solely for the personal domestic consumption of the recipient and shall be used for no other purpose whatsoever. If any recipient contravenes this provision he/she shall thereupon forfeit his/her right to receive benefit under this Agreement.

Benefit will be provided only to staff employed in a coalfield. Staff employed in Headquarters and other establishments which are not located in a coalfield will not be eligible for benefit in any circumstances.

Personal Entitlement

Staff who at the effective date of this Agreement have a coal or smokeless fuel entitlement greater than that appropriate under this Agreement, shall retain it on a personal basis until they are promoted or transferred from their present post or until they leave the service of the Corporation.

Where the new Agreement provides a lower fuel entitlement because of a changed definition, the person will retain his/her previous definition until there is a material change in circumstances, whereupon the provisions of this Agreement will apply.

Material Change in Circumstances

A concessionaire must inform the Corporation promptly of any material change in his/her circumstances. The Corporation may reject or terminate a person's entitlement to benefit under this Agreement in the event of that person furnishing false information in support of an application for benefit, or failing to inform the Corporation promptly of any material change in his/her circumstances. No persons residing outside Great Britain, Northern Ireland or the Isle of Man will be entitled to concessionary fuel.

No persons residing outside Great Britain will be entitled to cash in lieu in any circumstances.

Multiple Entitlements under this Agreement, any other Agreement, or both

The Corporation will supply only one allowance of concessionary fuel or cash in lieu per household irrespective of the number or class of individuals employed by the Corporation who live in that household.

An entitlement to concessionary fuel or cash in lieu will not be granted to both a widow/widower and a dependent parent as a result of the death of one individual.

Where at any time any person has more than one entitlement to concessionary fuel or cash in lieu such person will have in lieu of such entitlements a single entitlement equal to the largest entitlement.

Carry Over of Entitlement

Any part of the annual entitlement to benefit, including, for beneficiaries, any part-bag smokeless fuel entitlement, which is not taken in the Fuel Year in which it is due may not be carried forward from one Fuel Year to the next. Part-bag smokeless fuel entitlements for serving staff remaining at the end of a Fuel Year may be carried forward to be added to the following Year's entitlement.

Customary Practice

Clerical staff who elect to take a customary practice entitlement of coal in retirement will be eligible to apply for benefit under the Corporation's arrangements for retired staff and beneficiaries if they become infirm or subject to a smokeless zone on or after 1st August 1984. This concession applies to all applications made by beneficiaries on or after that date, irrespective of the date of their retirement.

Effect on other Agreements

This National Fuel Agreement for clerical staff will supersede all previous fuel Agreements for Clerical staff and all local arrangements and customary practice other than those specifically provided in a customary practice protected by the 1947 Coal Industry Nationalisation Act.

Nothing in this Agreement shall detract from the entitlements to concessionary fuel which are established under Section 37 of the Coal Industry Nationalisation Act 1946.
