Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act ('the Act') of 7th July 2014 seeking the following information:

*“Harry Gration is a presenter on bbc look north leeds.
Is he a member of Fulford golf club, or ever been a member, is he a committee member and has he enjoyed hospitality and/or free rounds of golf at that particular course?
I ask because I believe he had a conflict of interest in a particular broadcast which was no more than a promotion from that particular course.”*

We do not hold this information. All employees are obliged to fill out a declaration of interest form regularly and to declare any interest in a story should a conflict of interest situation arise.
