Dear Edward Briggs

I refer to your request where you asked:

“Please could you send me the original document released at the tender process for Consultancy One. I have try using the website on the original OJEU notice but it seems to be no longer valid.

I am not asking for any submissions or responses.”

I am writing to advise you that following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you requested is held by the Cabinet Office, including the Crown Commercial Service.

The requested information is exempt from disclosure under Section 21(1) of the Freedom of Information Act. Section 21 exempts information if this information is reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means. Section 21 is an absolute exemption and the Cabinet Office is not required to consider whether the public interest favours disclosure of this information.
