I am writing to advise you that the County Council is re-advertising its intention to make an order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of Stoney Middleton Byway Open to All Traffic No. 15 known as Jacobs Ladder. The notice will appear in the Sheffield Star and the Derbyshire Times on Thursday 6th September 2018.

Please find attached a document containing the notice, the draft order, location plan and the statement of reasons.

All objections must state the grounds on which they are made.

This notice replaces the previous notice of a proposed Order dated 17 May 2018. Any person who sent a response to that notice and who still wishes to make objections or representations should ensure that a new response is made.
