Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Request – 190309004

Thank you for your request dated 9 March 2019 in which you asked for the following information from the Ministry of Justice (MoJ):

(Please provide a) “copy of the Contract for collection of Approved Enforcement services in the West Yorkshire region”

Your request is being handled under the FOIA.

I am writing to inform you that we are required to conduct public interest tests in relation to your request. These tests are being carried out because some of the information you have requested is covered by section 43(2) of the FOIA – prejudicial to the commercial interests of any person, and because some information is covered by section 31(1)(c) of the FOIA – prejudicial to the administration of justice.

As yet, we have not reached a decision but are aiming to provide you with a full response by 8 May 2019.

Please also be advised that some information will be excluded under section 40(2) of the FOIA – third party personal information.

Appeal Rights

If you are not satisfied with this response you have the right to request an internal review by responding in writing to one of the addresses below within two months of the date of this response.
