NORMAL eGFR &SERUM CRREATINE

If eGFR is greater than 60 and Creatinine is normal (below 110)

When giving 100mls of contrast IV

DO NOT STOP METFORMIN

NO BLOOD RESULTS

Refer to a radiologist as you may need

Non-contrast scan.

Re booking of appt. or

Proceed with contrast, decision recorded by Radiologists on request form

ABNORMAL eGFR & SERUM CREATININE
