Freedom of Information Request

I refer to your Freedom of Information request which was received by South Tyneside Council on 23rd September 2011 and which was answered on the 12th October 2011. You contacted us on the 21st November 2011 with a narrower scope for consideration.

Your request (narrower scope)

Rather than request an internal review could I please ask you to narrow down my request to copies of all emails / letters which the Leader has sent me / Robertson Scaffolding Ltd from August 2010 to 23/09/11.

Council's response

Even though your request now does fall within the appropriate cost limit under section 12 of the Act the Council have decided to refuse your request and relies on upon the exemption contained within section 21 of the Act, namely that the information is available to you by other means. The Council is the view that any emails sent by the Leader of the Council to you personally or to Robertson Scaffolding Limited are already in your possession. This is an absolute exemption and the Council does not need to consider the public interest test before applying the exemption.

Internal Review Procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of this enquiry you can invoke the Council's internal review procedures to ask for an independent review of your request. All such requests must be sent to us within 4 weeks and must clearly state in writing your reference number and your reasons for your request for internal review.
