I don't know how we can be told that there is sufficient playing areas in the area. would you let your children walk 10 mins away across a very busy main road to play. I don't think so. Also not happy that there seems to be no set plans for safe-guarding the children round here while the work is going on. From what I have read the developers are planning to put a fence around the land while they build. what about the traffic that is coming through from Grove Street? If it is that only the lorries can have access to the site and anything else is barred that would be a big help. But there is nothing in the planning that makes this clear. Lindisfarne Road is a cul-de-sac and can't take any pressure of extra traffic cutting through from Newmarket Road. It was never designed to take a high volume of traffic and won't be safe. There is already a high volume of cars trying to get down Richmond Street at peak times and this will just make it a major gridlock and safety problem.

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
