

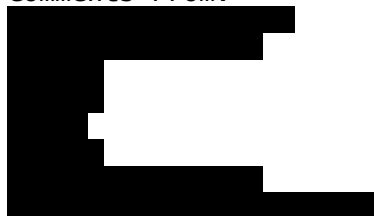

new plans. If you open

are regularly stuck on the
estate with no way out due to heavy traffic on every possible exit. We have very
