Some drivers also come down at speed and children have to get out of the way quickly.

The residents of Lindersfarne Close must be outraged. As the plan to open the end of their close on to the pathway for entrance to the new site will be very dangerous. There is no pavement on both sides and the gardens are all off set. Children play all over this area as it is fairly safe with just the residents cars on their drives.

Meanwhile the residents on Grove Street will be having to have big construction lorries going up and down their street. This will probably churn the road service up. which will then interrupt with the drainage system. T

his is not very good as it links up to the drains on Newmarket Road. which is always being dug up costing thousands.

Grove wood Close will be having no privacy if or when the houses are built which will put people off buying the houses.

[REDACTED] when Leech Homes let the council finish building the estate. [REDACTED] loads of power cuts over the years as the power sub stations were not big enough. The sewer pipes soon get blocked and the fresh water grids are never cleaned. So with more building being proposed it worries me what is going to happen in the future.

I have been informed by some residents that the council do not want the responsibility of maintaining the services as it is a private purchase of land.
