Thank you for all the work that went into setting up all these schemes so quickly and for the new webpage. We have been spared so far as we are still in quarantine but on Friday we'll do the school run for the first time in almost 6 months. A bit apprehensive.

Have you heard of issues with schools in Brent not letting parents leaving scooters and bicycles during the day at the school? Seems to be a wide spread problem elsewhere (my own school included). It really is unnecessary difficult to actively travel to school! I am to trying to think of a way. What's Brent policy on parklets? Within the covid/emergency school streets context, could an ETO be used? I have heard that local authorities could provide temporary cycle parking provision but haven't got much information about this.
