

Could you clarify what you are stating in the area highlighted in yellow please? The request of 4no. changing rooms was for diverse use for younger matches / junior / training 7v7 and 9v9 and 5v5 etc being split between male / female groups. I believe this has derived

There should be viewing on three sides with a 1.1m pitch perimeter barrier with infill. Currently there is not full length viewing on one side of the pitch. The hardstanding areas and covered stands should provide a total capacity 1,300.

Not sure which version of the plans you have been sent or if the thicker fence lines block viewing but a minimum of 1m hardstanding is proposed to all 4 sides/ends with a 1.1m high viewing / spectator fence and a 4.5m fence beyond (do we need 4.5m or can they reduce to 1.83m if planning have concerns of visual considerations?).(Ideally, needs to be 4.5m for ball retention)

The boundary fencing should prevent a direct view from the outside up to 1.8m. there will be a 1.83m visual mesh / screening around the entire 4.5m perimeter fence to meet the NGG clause.(Noted)

There should be 150 covered seats and 150 covered standing for spectators. Work for spectator accommodation and associated facilities must meet the requirements of the Local Certifying Authority (where one exists), comply with all Health and Safety laws and the provisions and highest standards of the Guide to Safety of Sports Grounds (the Green Guide) 6th Edition and other advice to which it refers.

Apologies this is an error from me on the annotation that has not been updated for the seating / stand of the site. The NGG that needs to be met is step 5 that requires 200 spectator accommodation with at least 100 seated. The proposal is actually for a stand to serve 250 seated and if the club progress to step 4 then they would then just need to add a 50 standing accommodation to meet ground grading step 4. (Noted)

There should be in additional to the Club house toilets male toilet with 2 urinals and 1 WC. Female toilet with 2 WCS.

The remit was/is currently to meet step 5 and allow future proofing to step 4 and allow future proofing and space allocation for step 4 of further external toilets. That said the architect has been made aware that the toilets need to increase to include one with 2 urinals and the other with a 2nd toilet. With this alteration / addition are you happy for the amendment? (Yes) There should be within the pavilion a separated area that could accommodate up to 24 people (directors of both Clubs).

This is currently the social space on match days and competitive league events. If you are suggesting this area needs to double in size then two changing rooms will certainly need to be lost and all elements re-configured? (If this space can accommodate 24 people, that's fine) The officials changing room should provide lobby, shower, WC, WHB plus 6sqm of usable changing area.

There is no NGG request for a lobby? That said the rooms have an access corridor / lobby space? There is also a shower, WHB and 6m area. can you confirm which plans you were sent please? (Noted, all fine)

The Designs should be the requirements of The FA National Ground Grading – Category D. The current remit we were working to is step 5 with future proof capacity to step 4. Can all parties just confirm what the works should be installed and implemented to please? (We need the LA to confirm this, but last email we saw was step 4)
