Dear

The latest position is that we have undertaken a site visit and confirmed that a general tidy up has taken place with some unsightly fence panels being removed and undergrowth being cut back. The current car parking operation doesn't benefit from a valid planning consent, however since the LPA has previously granted planning permission for this use it is unlikely that if permission were sought it would be refused and as such it is not in my opinion expedient nor in the public interest to pursue formal enforcement action in respect of the use.

I have advised the site owner that it is in their interest to regularise the use as a car park by way of another planning application in addition to which I will be preparing a report for the Delegated Planning Meeting setting out the case that it is neither expedient nor in the public interest to pursue this formally as explained above.

Should the report be accepted by the Head of Development Control then I will write to you setting out the position and the case will be closed. Should the report be rejected by the head of service then I will review the options available and advise accordingly

One option available to the LPA, should an alternative view be taken, may be the service of a temporary stop notice to prevent the use of the car park for a period of 28 days. I would stress that this is a power not to be used lightly and whilst it may be considered a means to an end the implications need to be carefully considered for the following reasons

- 1) The LPA has accepted the use of this parcel of land as acceptable for the parking of vehicles therefore the service of a stop notice may be considered excessive and unreasonable should the matter be resolved at appeal via the Planning Inspectorate and expose the Local Authority to the risk of a compensation claim.
- 2) The economic impact upon both the public and traders in the area being prevented from using a centrally located car park.

In respect of the framework on which the previous fence panels were placed, I have stressed to the site owner that this should be removed in the interim and I am awaiting confirmation of when this work will be undertaken, as soon as I have a timeframe I will let you know.

There was some litter in the site built this is not a planning enforcement matter and certainly not of a level that would warrant the service of a Section 215 notice.

I would reiterate that the above is the opinion of an officer and not binding upon the Local Planning Authority, I hope the above is of assistance if I can be of any further help please do not hesitate to contact me.
