We very much doubt it comes in below those other services as the copper pipe and the terracotta pipe are probably older (installed before) the plastic gas pipe. I have annotated one of the plans with the rough location the grounds man identified (in yellow).

Apologies if this has already been covered but did any pf the photos detect the larger gas main believed to be beneath the water and comms?

"The "live" gas that you are referring to is indicated on National Grids plan as being a 250mm PE (plastic) service. As mentioned earlier because this is plastic (inert) we could only deploy ground penetrating radar to

locate this however it would appear to be in the area where we have already found two water services, two comm's services and an unknown service ( which may or may not be the gas service in question )

It is highly likely that if the gas service is underneath the located water and comm's services then the ground penetrating radar would not be able to see it, as it would be "masked" by the shallower services that have "**Gary Lindop**
