We have had a complaint from residents about the condition of the site, especially the grass area by Spruce Hill and Forest Road. There is one trench section apparently still not filled in and now debris building up in it and it is unsafe. This is apparently located near the brick shed by our neighbour's house. The new owners of the land have contacted us for an update also.

"an abandoned trench with exposed piping adjacent to the turning circle at the top of the road. This is filling up with refuse. There is a manhole with cover removed next to my house and there are brambles growing from your site up the side of my house to a height of over 6ft."

We are unable to complete our BT and Virgin connections as access to the chambers is prohibited and full of water, I do realise we still have a leak which will be resolved when we undertake the water mains connection.

Can we please have:

- Site tidied and made safe urgently where possible
- Clear and backfill the unsafe trench at the brick shed – evidence of clearing should be provided to us.
- Date of water connection – Realise you are waiting for TW, but eta would be helpful.
- Date of Gas mains connection, thought this was today but????
- Info of Gas disconnection for the STEM Centre??? Is it today, has it been done??

Look forward to hearing from you.

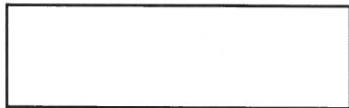
