As you may well know by now quite a few residents here have experienced problems with The Barry Howard building site AND now the on an on goings of the road and roundabout.

After a few days respite, today, even in the rain, a very large vehicle is cleaning the paths! The vibrations in my house is absolutely driving me mad. I went outside to question why they needed to do this for hours on end, and was advised an inspector was coming to view later? I asked one of the men to request the inspector comes to my door to explain why on earth this torment is needed to perfectly clean paths. I do wonder if they have nothing else better to do on that site.

I then rang the Street doc at the council and for 28mins was given the run around, having worked at Mid Beds council for decades I am astonished at the lack of customer care there. Totally unable to find out who the inspector is or from what department.

I hope you have appreciated my total frustration regarding the lack of consideration with this issue, as, my husband and I for health reasons have been in total isolation since March enduring the Barry Howard invasion.

The houses and roads on the development were owned by a completely separate BH company to the green space.

That development company was dissolved in 2016 and any remaining property (the roads) could be claimed by the Crown, but they would disclaim them as not profitable to them.

The separate BH company that owned the green space became 'Realisation 1237 Limited' – which still exists and has been under receiver action since 2013 with a long list of debts.

Barry is still the director of Realisation 1237 Limited, so all this 'good-will gesture' is annoying. The s106 agreement says he has to maintain it. Doing what he's legally obliged to do isn't a favour.

The Royal Bank of Scotland have a fixed charge on the green space (and some other land) to get money owed to them – which might be where the Crown come in, but it's the Bank not the Crown, and they shouldn't be paid any money by NBC, in fact the \$106\$ agreement says the council is owed £25,000 index linked from 1990.

If I remember right the road that runs over the Tunnel (and only that road) is under a third company – which may or may not still exist, I don't remember.

The s106 agreement for that site is easy – wait until they come up with the one for Harvester Way!







Whilst there has been some progress with this, it is still slow.

This development was subject to a bankruptcy order associated with a company, that was previously part of Barry Howard Homes.

As a result of this, the land became the responsibility of the Crown rather than the developer, which is who we are now having to negotiate with. The most recent update that I received from our solicitor about 2 weeks ago, indicated that we are very close to agreeing that the transfer can take place, which will then mean the legal process can be finalised.

As previously advised, I will update you when the land transfer of the open space has been completed.

In respect of the open space, although they were strictly not responsible for the land, Barry Howard Homes agreed to clear the fly-tipping from the ditch (I believe this amounted to three lorry loads of furniture and other rubbish) and carried out a lot of maintenance on the landscaping, particularly relating to the trees around the play area. This was carried out as a final goodwill gesture and was inspected by the Neighbourhood Warden following the clearance.

I am aware that you have previously been in contact with at NCC, regarding the adoption of the highways. I would suggest that you contact direct regarding this point, which is a matter for the Local Highway Authority.



Given that this new roundabout is far bigger than the MINI ROUNDABOUT that we were told was being built, and that on a particularly dangerous part of Lancaster Way in wintery conditions, there is every possibility that at some point soon a vehicle will "take out" the substation or cause themselves considerable damage. This part of Lancaster Way is well known to local residents as being particularly icy in the winter, all of whom take great care. I also believe that Highways didn't see fit to tarmac this part of Lancaster Way with an antiskid surface that it really will be fun in the winter.

The application form states quite clearly that no work or change of use has started. Really? Am I (and several other residents) seeing big green boxes appear in front of our very eyes? And yes, the loss of that hedgerow does influence the importance of the local landscape character. While it is being corrected, in the agreement submitted for application N/2019/0295, in relation to the development in application N/2012/0909, it was stated that the 'Owner', Barry Howard Homes (Towcester Road) Limited, acquired the unregistered plots 40/42, 8, and 50B on the 25th May 2018.

This raises a number of questions:-

- The s106 agreement from application N/2012/0909 states that the 'Owner' should have informed NBC immediately that this acquisition had occurred. Could you confirm that this was not done?
- According to that same legal agreement, on the 'Owner' informing NBC that they had acquired this unregistered land (or any of the land marked yellow) a supplementary s106 agreement is required to ensure this land remains entirely as open space in perpetuity and not made, for instance, into part of a roadway. 

Thank you for your comments on the recent occupation of the above site. The Council has noted the occupations, and undertaken a review of the legal position of the site. The majority of conditions are now discharged, and the few elements of these which are outstanding do not represent serious breaches of control. It is also noted that the revised 2019 scheme (ref N/2019/1277) was approved in principle at the Planning Committee meeting on the 28th of July 2020, and that this scheme includes details of the outstanding issues.
On that basis, whilst the Council understands, and shares residents frustration at the lack of regard to due process demonstrated during the life of this development, at this point in time it would not be rational or in the public interest to take enforcement action when the development is so close to being regularised. However, it should be noted that the approval in principle of the 2019 scheme, agreed on 28th July this year, was done so on the basis that if the required s106 agreement is not agreed within 3 months of the Committee meeting, the application can be refused under delegated authority, on the grounds that necessary mitigation measures have not been secured in order to make the proposal acceptable.

# Good afternoon

Please find attached a briefing note on the legal position regarding development at Lancaster Way, wherein we have been advised by QC that, given the limited nature and number of breaches, and in light of the extant resolution to grant permission for the revised scheme which resolves all of the outstanding issues, it would not be pragmatic, reasonable or in the public interest to take action against these.

Whilst this is not going to be popular with the neighbouring residents, I am satisfied that the advice is consistent with both national, and our own enforcement policy. Taking enforcement action is discretionary and in doing so the Council must be satisfied that it would be in the public interest to do so.

However, it is also noted that if the required \$106 agreement for the revised scheme is not agreed within 3

months of the Committee meeting (28/7/20), the application could be refused under delegated authority. I will shortly be advising the members of the public who have commented on this matter of this position. Happy to answer any questions.

Hi Julie - thank yo for forwarding email. I know you're busy, so will just bullet point my response to it ...

Maybe I should mention that my is retired Legal Examiner at the Land Registry and she has been assisting me with this enquiry, would be happy to explain the legal but perhaps should involve the council's own legal team? happy to talk to them as well if required.

- 1 The service road is included in my title deeds as my property, extending to the edge of of the service road as indicated in red on my map and I have absolute title (this means down to the centre of the earth, with the sky as the upper limit). There is no mention of sub soil in my deeds from when I became the title holder in 1998 or in the original ones from 1946.
- 2. It is clear from the 1946 conveyance that the service road is subject to rights of way for the benefit of the houses fronting it only, until such time as the service road is taken over by the local authority it was not intended as a right of way for other users and as such the local authority do not have the right to direct traffic to use it. There is no evidence to support the view that the local authority adopted the service road in 1966. There may have been an intention to adopt it at some point but this was never legally acted completed. The map on my deeds has a stamp dated 1972, so it wasn't adopted then either.
- 3. If the local authority believe they have taken over the service road, they need to provide paper evidence of this. If they can do this they need to lodge it at the Land Registry for their records AND inform every house owner that this is the case. The Council will then be responsible for the maintenance thereof. Currently this is not the case as it is NOT registered with the Land Registry and the current title holders are liable for the maintenance of the part of the service road that their property fronts.
- 4. Simply showing the service road coloured green on a map (as provided by I not mean it was legally transferred. It is interesting to note that the map that provided shows the road layout with the Gloucester Avenue roundabout in situ, yet that roundabout wasn't built until access for the Buckingham Fields estate was required circa 1995/96/97. The original layout of the road can be seen in the map attached to my title deeds, clearly showing and stating it is a service road.

I would respectively suggest that discusses this with his legal department and get them to provide paper evidence that they have adopted the service road, and to then proceed to make it legal accordingly. Until they do the right of way is as stated in the 1946 conveyance, only for the benefit of the houses fronting the service road. And they most definitely should not be directing traffic to use it.

Apart from the issue of increased traffic on our service road, I am concerned that this matter reaches the correct legal conclusion, as should the subject of widening the Towcester Road arise again (as it did many years ago), the Council need to realise that they do not own the service road and they cannot use it for widening purposes, nor can they direct traffic to use and they certainly cannot just colour it on a map and call it theirs!

I have been in contact with our land Searches Team who have advised that some of the properties show their registered title to include the service road, others don't - it's about 50% either way.

Some of the properties have original 1940s/50's conveyance documents available online via Land Registry and they show the service road as having been transferred as part of the property but it then says that maintenance would be the responsibility of the vendor (ie the developer) and then his successors in title (which could be taken as being the homeowners) until such time as it's taken on by the local authority. This road has appeared on NCC Highway Registers since at least 1966, maybe earlier, so we would argue that this has happened and the road is now the responsibility of the local authority.

This doesn't mean it can't still be shown on title plans etc, it would just mean that ownership in that area would be of the subsoil effectively now.

The property in question this time does not have their original conveyance available electronically but a nearby property has (as have others I've downloaded in the past) and it is attached for reference with the crucial section highlighted.

Thank you for your comments on the recent occupation of the above site. The Council has noted the occupations, and undertaken a review of the legal position of the site. The majority of conditions are now discharged, and the few elements of these which are outstanding do not represent serious breaches of control that in the Council's opinion, would cause unacceptable harm. It is also noted that the revised 2019 scheme (ref N/2019/1277) was approved in principle at the Planning Committee meeting on the 28th of July 2020, and that this scheme includes acceptable details in relation to the outstanding issues.

On that basis, whilst the Council understands, and shares residents frustration at the lack of regard to due process demonstrated during the life of this development, at this point in time it would not be rational or in the public interest to take enforcement action when the development is so close to being regularised. However, it should be noted that the approval in principle of the 2019 scheme, agreed on 28th July this year, was done so on the basis that if the required s106 agreement is not agreed within 3 months of the Committee meeting, the application can be refused under delegated authority, on the grounds that necessary mitigation measures have not been secured in order to make the proposal acceptable.

I trust that this answers your query.



Thank you for your e-mail.

We are still waiting for a more in-depth site specific management plan for dust rather than the generic document submitted. Currently I am working through getting the contaminated land issues tied up at the moment with BBH's geo-environmental consultant.

I am not aware about a dust barrier being erected along the boundary with Briar Hill Walk. If it forms part of the dust management plan another officer has reviewed it for reasons of impartiality (to avoid a poacher turned gamekeeper scenario being created).

I will press for the plan to be resubmitted. Unfortunately non COVID compliant licenced premises are taking up some of my time with the outfall of noise issues.

In respect to this site I think since the onset of the warning notice dust is being managed better from what I saw from my unannounced visit.

I have copied in the Planning Enforcement team who investigate reported breaches of planning control.

With regards to contamination I can advise that Condition 12 of N/2012/0909 required details of possible contaminants on the site. Details were agreed for this condition and this condition is not in breach under the planning regulations.

Application N/2019/1277 would include a condition 9:

9. 'Within one month of the date of this decision notice a desk top study in respect of possible contaminants within the site shall be completed and a site investigation designed. The scope and methodology of the desk top study and the site investigation report shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The site investigation and appropriate risk assessments shall be carried out and the results shall be used to produce a method statement for the necessary remedial works (and a phasing programme), which shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. All remedial works shall be fully implemented in accordance with the approved method statement and phasing programme. Confirmation of the full implementation of the scheme and validation report(s) shall be submitted to the Local Planning Authority within 2 weeks of completion (or within 2 weeks of completion of each respective phase).

Reason: To ensure the effective investigation and remediation of contaminated land sites and in the interests of health and safety and the quality of the environment in accordance with the advice contained in the National Planning Policy Framework and Policy BN9 of the West Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy.'

A decision notice has not yet been issued on this variation application and as such there is no breach of conditions under application N/2019/1277.

I am, however, aware that the consultants are working with Game Smith to address this condition now and have been discussing parameters and approaches with Game.
