Apologies for not doing this, something else always gets in the way!

We are progressing the design and have re-visited the original proposal. The new outline does not require as much third party land and will cost significantly less than originally anticipated. However, we still have not secured funding for this scheme through the LTP allocation or S106 contributions, so currently are not approaching the land owner to negotiate the purchase.
