Thank you for your memo of 03 February 2012 regarding the above.

I can advise that Clay Cross Footpath 23 and Footpath 26 run through the site outlined on the site location plan. An extract from the Working Copy of the Definitive Map is attached and I should be grateful if you would make the applicant aware of the legal alignment of the path. The applicant should be advised as follows:-

- The route must remain open, unobstructed and on its legal alignment at all times.
- There should be no disturbance to the surface of the path without prior authorisation from Michelle Sergeant, the Rights of Way Inspector for the area
- Consideration should be given to members of the public using the path at all times.
- A temporary closure of the footpath may be granted to facilitate public safety subject to certain conditions. Further information may be obtained by contacting Julie Bishop in the Rights of Way Section.
- If a structure is to be erected adjacent to the public footpath, it should be installed within the site boundary so that the width of the right of way is not encroached upon.
