The company that is considering to surface mine coal at Hilltop Farm, Clay Cross is Provectus. Their planning agent is CJ S Planning, 43 Station Road, Glenfield, Leicester, LE3 8BU.

The outline proposals that have been shared is to excavate approximately 200,000 tonnes of coal from the site over a period of 3 ½ years from the commencement of operations to the completion of restoration works. The ground levels and overall landform of the restored site would be based on those existing prior to development and the applicant states that the restoration strategy would be designed to improve the overall quality of the land and return it to agricultural uses. The proposal does not include importation of any materials
