Freedom of Information Act 2000: Factual Paper on the Barnett Formula

Thank you for your request dated 15 January 2009 in which you asked:

"how much in total was the cost of the factual paper on the Barnett Formula?"

I confirm that the Treasury does not hold information matching the description of your request.
