Further to your recent information request concerning the cost of a temporary set of traffic lights on Dunchurch Road.

I can confirm that the information requested is held by Warwickshire County Council and I have detailed below the information that is being released to you.

*The temporary pedestrian crossing (traffic lights) on Dunchurch Road, near the Overslade Lane junction is being provided on behalf of the Developer of a school site in close proximity to the junction and as a condition of Planning Consent granted for redevelopment of the school site. All related costs are being borne by the Developer and therefore there is no weekly cost to the Council.*
