**Re: Your request for information: Ref No. 4721**

Thank you for your request for information that was received on 27 January 2010 in which you requested:

**Under The Local Authorities (Model Code of Conduct) Order 2007 No. 1159, it is required that members register their interests if the interests may have an affect on business considered. At present the mode of transport favoured by members is not listed yet, for example, a member who cycles could be biased toward cycle improvements as opposed to public transport, pedestrian or car transport.**

**The information requested within this context is:**

**1.a) Number of members using cars - fossil fuelled - as their main mode of transport**

**1.b) Number of members using cars - electric - as their main mode of transport**

**2.) Number of members using cycles as their main mode of transport**

**3.) Number of members using buses as their main mode of transport**

**4.) Number of members using trains as their main mode of transport**

**5.) Number of members using the underground as their main mode of transport**

**6.) Number of members who are mainly walk**

Your request is being dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and you will receive a response within 20 working days of the date that we received your request.

If the information you requested contains reference to a third party then they may be consulted before a decision is taken on whether or not to release the information to you. You will be informed if this is the case.

The Act defines a number of exemptions that may restrict the release of the requested information. There will be an assessment and if any of the exemption categories apply

then the information may not be released. You will be informed if this is the case, including your rights of appeal.
