Thank you for your request for information received on 11 May 2021 to the Group Data Protection Officer addressed to the Port of Liverpool Police concerning crime statistics.

Your request has been forwarded to and is being dealt with by The Mersey Docks and Harbour Company Limited ("the Company") under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ("the FOIA").

The Company is only a public authority by virtue of Paragraph 64 of Schedule 1, Part V of the FOIA. As such, it is a public authority in respect of information relating to the exercise by any person appointed on its nomination of the functions of a special constable.

In relation to your request, we would respond as follows:

All crimes dealt with by the Port of Liverpool Police are recorded by Merseyside Police and form part of the statistics that they submit to the Home Office.
