I write in connection with your request for information which was received by Derbyshire Constabulary on 15/06/2019. I note you seek access to the following information:

and during 2018, how many people classed as IC6 were arrested (charged or not) by officers of your force area for the same

- 1. Breach of the peace
- 2. Hate Speech specifically against disability, race, religion, sexual orientation or transgender identity 3. Section 5 of the POA

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Derbyshire Constabulary to locate any relevant information. The searches located some information relevant to your request.

Decision

I have today decided to disclose the located information to you in full.

There are 32 Custody Records with an Arrest date in 2018, excluding 'Voluntary Attendance', with Primary Arrest 'Y' & Offence Description (Arrest) relating to 'Breach of the Peace' with Officer Defined Ethnicity 1.White Northern European; there were 0 with 2.White South European and 6.Middle Eastern.





There are 139 Custody Records with an Arrest date in 2018, excluding 'Voluntary Attendance', with Primary Arrest 'Y' & Offence Description (Arrest) relating to 'Hate Speech specifically against disability, race, religion, sexual orientation or transgender identity' with officer defined ethnicity 1.White Northern European; there were 4 with 2.White South European and 0.Middle Eastern.

Police forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide crime statistics
to government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the
systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures
used locally in capturing the crime data. It should be noted that for these reasons
this Constabulary's response to your questions should not be used for comparison
purposes with any other response you may receive.
