Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on 26 March 2016. You asked:

RE: Customer's sensitive personal data and community work placements.

In regard FOI 0682 please send me full details of the "certain information" a claimant can delete from their Action Plan?

In the context of a referral to Community Work Placements, a claimant could choose to delete all 'sensitive personal data' contained within the Action Plan. The categories of sensitive information under DPA are:

- health or physical condition
- race/ethnic origin
- sexual orientation
- religious beliefs
- trade union membership
- any offence committed by them or any court proceedings against them.

With the exception of that relating to agreed employment restrictions and a potential need for the provider to put in place reasonable adjustments or additional support, a claimant could also choose to delete any other, more general, personal data that has been added to the free text fields within the Aims, Employment History and Information sections of their Action Plan.

This other, more general, personal data is that gathered during work coach interviews over the course of a claim and considered relevant, by both work coach and claimant, for inclusion on the Action Plan. As this will be unique to each individual it is not possible to provide 'full details' of what this might be.
