Dear Mr Jones,

Thank you for your email of 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2018 which requested the following information:

*I understand that Typhoon Tranche 2 and 3 will be fitted with a Collision Warning System by the end of 2019. Can you advise me as to the system being fitted?*

I am treating your email as a request for information under the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000. I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held. The first stage of a Typhoon Enhanced Collision Awareness System is being delivered by adapting and enhancing existing sensor systems on Tranche 2 and Tranche 3 aircraft to provide greater situational awareness of collision threats and risks in the vicinity. The system will provide both visual and audio warnings to avoid the collision risk. This initial capability is planned for late 2019.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail [CIO-FOI-IR@mod.gov.uk](mailto:CIO-FOI-IR@mod.gov.uk)). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
