Unique Access Code	This will be in your registration email from your Police CyberAlarm Contact
A Virtual Appliance to run the collector	The appliance will require 2 CPU Cores, 2GB RAM and 25GB Disk space

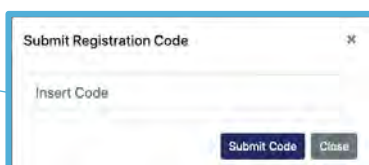
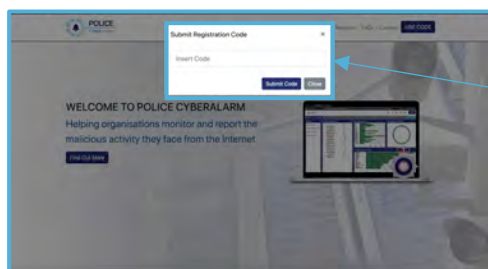
Police CyberAlarm Registration



Upon receipt of your 'Unique Access Code' visit <https://cyberalarm.police.uk> click on the 'Use Code' button at the top of the page as seen below.



When the 'Redeem Code' box appears, enter your Unique Access Code, then press 'Submit'.



On your initial log in to the Police CyberAlarm site you will need to complete your joining process by providing the following information.



Organisation Details	Basic Information about your organisation
Project Sponsor	This is the person who is championing the scheme within your organisation.
Reporting Contact	The person whom you would like to receive reports.
External IP(s) Website URL(s)	The public facing IP address and website URL for the vulnerability scanning, also the frequency of the scan.

You are also required to accept the Police CyberAlarm Terms and Conditions before submitting your information.

After you have completed your registration process you will then be forwarded to the Data Collector Installation Instructions including information about Police CyberAlarm and how to set up and use your free Police Cyber Alarm System.

You can revisit this page at any time by returning to the Police CyberAlarm Website and entering your Unique Access Code (note: you will not be required to complete your details after your first visit).

PLEASE NOTE: Your Unique Access Code should be retained as you will not be able to register your Police CyberAlarm Collector without it. This code can also be used to access the Police CyberAlarm Data Collector Installation instructions, on the Police CyberAlarm website.
