THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (HOSPITAL BRIDGE ROAD, WHITTON) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2001

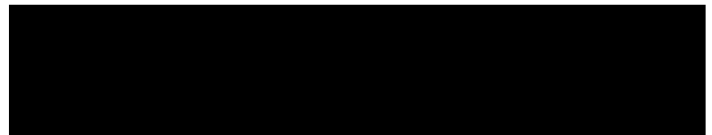

Coming into operation 5 November 2001

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84 and Parts I to III of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 5 November 2001 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Hospital Bridge Road, Whitton) (20 mph speed limit) Order 2001.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in that length of Hospital Bridge Road, Whitton lying between the common boundary of Nos. 203 and 205 Hospital Bridge Road and the common boundary of Nos. 214 and 216 Hospital Bridge Road.
3. Nothing in this Order shall apply:-
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
 - (b) to any person who causes a vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to sections 66 and 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Order introduces a 20 mph speed limit in a section of Hospital Bridge Road, Whitton as part of the Council's continuing strategy to target road safety and environmental improvements so as to benefit, and give greater priority to school children in particular but also other pedestrians and cyclists in certain selected areas.
