Progress reports – January 2011 summary

Member updates – highlights

TfL

- Third burst of HGV and motorist cycle safety campaign planned for March 2011
- There are now 33 Delivery Service Plans (DSPs) registered with TfL and guidance has been published on delivering DSPs.
- The Freight Journey Planner now has consultants commissioned to develop a user interface.
- The HGV technology trial is due to start in February for 4 weeks. This will be completed by March 2011 and results available in spring.
- The Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC) course has now be delivered to 160 drivers.

CTC

IAM

- IAM will assist CEMEX with the filming of the forthcoming cycle safety video.
- IAM is in discussion with CTC and LCC to create mutually supportive relationships and discuss how the voluntary sector can assist cycling in the UK.

Road Peace

- Met with Crossrail to discuss their policies and procedures for reducing lorry danger.
- Ongoing discussion with CEMEX on documenting their good practice.
- Agreed to contact all MEPs to request support for Written Directive promoting use of sensors and cameras to eradicate blind spot.
- Begun developing briefing for coroners and collision investigators on what can be done to design out blind spots.

MPS

- Exchanging places events: Kennington Park – 9th December - MPS Cycle Taskforce worked with Lambeth STT to undertake Exchanging Places event in the area, during the 90 minute morning rush hour. 29 cyclists were dealt with and 9 bicycles marked. Week of activity in Islington tackling all road user behaviour, week commencing 24th January.

- Capital Cycle Safe: The pilot, which lasts until March, is so far well received with 222 FPNs issued and an 80% compliance rate. The course will be evaluated in partnership with TfL. Only the Traffic cycle team and CoLP use the system at the moment.
