Thank you for your information request of 15th June 2020 You requested the following information:

How many registered national standard cycling instructors are there in the UK?

How many registered national standard cycling instructors are there in London?

Of these instructors, is it known how many are actively practicing cycle training both nationally and within London?

Our 2018 data collection calculated an estimated 2,500, England registered National Standard cycle instructors. A further data collection is currently ongoing and will be made available in August 2020. Our instructor database currently records 786 instructors domiciled in London, however this is likely to include some who have stopped delivering Bikeability. The Department for Transport do not hold a geographical record of active practicing instructors.
