<p>Applicant Clarification...</p> <p>For clarification, I am looking for data from your council noting how many care homes have changed hands from council-owned to under a private name or contractor. I would like to find this information related to adult care homes, including names and years from 2014 - present.</p> <p>If so, I would like to know the monetary transaction involved.</p>
