# Your request for information

Thank you for your request for information, which we received on the 26 July 2018. Your request has been reviewed and responded to as a legal obligation pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

### Your request

I am looking for data on homeowners that are behind on their mortgage payments. They may have had a court hearing and have fallen into arrears. We buy houses quickly so we want to offer the vendors a solution to this and offer our service.

I know the court hearings are public data and it can be requested, so could you please supply us with this data?

### Our response

We confirm that we do not hold information on homeowners who have fallen behind on their mortgage payments. Court hearing data constitutes information that may be held in the records of relevant courts, and is not information that is held by Southwark Council. Under section 1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, we confirm that we do not hold the requested data.

Under our duty to advise and assist, we advise that any requests for information held by courts should be requested directly from the relevant court.

Please note that under the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 Southwark Council ask not to receive unsolicited marketing communications.
