You asked us:

"The NRS website states that "In the week 22-28 February, 227 deaths were registered that mentioned COVID-19 on the death certificate, a decrease of 64 deaths from the previous week."

What are the mean, median and mode ages of death involving COVID-19 that have been recorded for Week 8: 22 - 28 February (n = 227)?".
