Thank you for your request dated 17 February 2020 under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA).

You asked for :

The EU statistics (classified according to the Standard international trade classification (SITC), Revision 4). state imports from UK as €194 bn , and exports to UK as €319 bn .

What is the Scottish value and percentage estimated by the Scottish government of UK exports €194 bn / and UK imports of €319 bn

Response to your request

While our aim is to provide information whenever possible, in this instance the Scottish Government does not have the information you have requested. However, you may wish to contact HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) who do publish this information as part of their Regional Trade Statistics. Further information can be found on their website. Note their recent data is up to quarter 3 of 2019 which means the full 2019 data is yet to be published.
