Your request for information received on 9 February 2017 has been dealt with under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

You asked:

I would like to know if you hold any documents that pertain to the decision made by the university to change its name from Middlesex University to Middlesex University London

### **University Response**

The University has not changed its name. The University's full name is Middlesex University Higher Education Corporation and this is usually shortened to Middlesex University. The term Middlesex University London is used for marketing purposes when referring to services or activities relating to the University's London campus as opposed to other campuses such as Dubai or Mauritius.

I trust this satisfies your request sufficiently. Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, you have the right to complain about the University's response to your request for information.
