I can confirm that the information requested is held by Birmingham City Council. I have detailed below the information that is being released to you.

### Request

I am looking for information as to the authorities prediction of the number of required placements over next 12 months, for adults with LD, and ASD in the following service types:

- \* Supported Living
- \* Residential Care

### Response

- For residential care for people with Learning disabilities (all ages), the numbers of long-term packages are likely to reduce from 637 at present, to around 605 by March 2022, if current trends continue.
- For long-term supported living for those with LD, the prediction based on current trends is an increase from 371 at present, to around 415 by March 2022.
