Do you require a breakdown of both potential and confirmed victims of trafficking?

If you provide the clarification requested, we will aim to send you a response to your request or inform you how you can refine your request further within twenty working days. If we do not receive clarification of your request within three months from the date of this letter, we will consider this request to be closed.
