## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST - REFERENCE NO: 001648/21

## **Result of Searches**

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Derbyshire Constabulary to locate any relevant information. The searches located some information relevant to your request.

## **Decision**

I have today decided to disclose the located information to you in full. Please see attached spreadsheet.

In relation to this data please note the following:

- The data has been extracted from the Constabulary's Crime System which is, to all intent a 'living' system in that it is constantly being updated. As such the data can only be verified for the date/time extracted.
- The data relates to Burglary, Robbery and Theft Offences, excluding 'Bicycle theft, Vehicle Crime, Shoplifting, Burglary Business/Non-Domestic' & 'No & Restricted Offences', with MO Free Text matches pattern 'DOG', recorded in the years shown, from 21/06/2016 to 31/12/2020 on the area of Derby.





- Please note that due to a change in the Constabulary's crime system on 21 June 2016 data is only available post this date.
- Police forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide crime statistics to
  government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems
  used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in
  capturing the crime data. It should be noted that for these reasons this Constabulary's
  response to your questions should not be used for comparison purposes with any other
  response you may receive.
