- **When you have made a permanent reinstatement and are leaving the site**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

THE STREET WORKS (CHARGES FOR UNREASONABLY PROLONGED OCCUPATION OF THE HIGHWAY) REGULATIONS 2001.

Section 74 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 has been implemented in Cambridgeshire, which means charges for unreasonable prolonged occupation of the Highway can be made.

This means that if a Street works Licence holder does not give the proper notices of starting and ending their works, or if they take longer to complete the works they have given notice for, they will be subject to the following charges:
