- Duty on local authorities to improve the well-being of young children and reduce inequalities between them. (Section 1).
- Duty on local authorities to make arrangements to secure that early childhood services in their area are provided in an integrated manner (Section 3).
- Arrangements to be made by LA to ensure that there are sufficient Children Centres, so far as reasonably practical, to meet local need. (Section 5A).

Children Centres statutory guidance (relevant points):

Section 2. Sufficient children centres:

- Local authorities MUST takes steps to identify parents and those expecting a baby in their area who are likely to take advantage if early childhood services available and encourage them to use them.
- Ensure there are sufficient Children's Centres, so far as reasonably practical to meet local need.
