Hi Jake,

Thanks for sending this through. The proposed area has been subject to a recent geophysical survey and subsequent evaluation trenching; this evaluation identified several archaeological features relating to Bronze Age and Iron Age activity. These features were centralised in the North West part of the proposed site, and while not of national significance may still require mitigation. As a result, it is possible that a programme of archaeological works would be required to target the features should development impact on them.

I am happy to discuss any options further
